

## 8. Automation of Federal Courts/ Tribunals, Islamabad-(Phase-1)

The Project titled “Automation of Federal Courts/ Tribunals, Islamabad-(Phase-1)” was approved at the cost of Rs. 49.179 million for the Federal Courts situated in Islamabad. The key features of the Project include Case Institution, Case Fixation, Copies of Judgments, Case Document Archiving, Generation of Cause List (daily, weekly), Progress Report (weekly, monthly, yearly), SMS Alert Generation to the Litigants and Lawyers before the hearing of the case.
