Dear Sir,

The undersigned is directed to refer to your office letter No.F.07(1)/2018-A.IV, dated 18<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 received to this office through e-mail on 18.04.2018 on the above noted subject. The requisite information in respect of Customs Appellate Tribunal, Bench -- III, Karachi is as under:-

- i) The Customs Appellate Tribunal, Bench - III, Karachi has been established under Section 194 of the Customs Act, 1969. The functions of Tribunal has defined under Section 194, 194-A, 194-B and 194-C of the Customs Act, 1969 as well as in Customs, Excise & Sales Tax Appellate (Procedure) Rules, 2006 are governed under the aforesaid Act, 1969. Section 194 of the Act, 1969 describes the terms and conditions of the service and mode of appointment of Member Judicial and Member Technical as well as supporting officers and ministerial staff. The terms and conditions of their services are being dealt by the Ministry of Law & Justice, Government of Pakistan.
- ii) The sanctioned budget for the current financial year 2017-2018 is Rs.2,27,06,000/-. Copy of the sanctioned budget is enclosed as Annexure 'A'.
- iii) The detail of appeals pendency and disposal for the period from January, 2018 to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2018 is attached as Annexure 'B'.



  - (ii) Hearing Notices in English and Urdu language.
  - (iii) Publication of Judgments / Orders in English and Urdu.
  - (iv) Daily / weekly roasters.
- vi) In order to implement the aforesaid, the use of website for official purpose. The following steps would be required to be taken:-
- a) Creation of posts / Employment of IT Experts / Programmers / Data Entry Operators.
  - b) Training of present staff through IT Departments, Government of Pakistan / Government of Sindh.
  - c) Advance and High Tech Computer equipments.
